



Regulations for the Inter - County finals 2019

- 1 To be eligible for the finals, a player must have played in one County League match in his/her elected age group during the season and cannot play down a age group in the finals.
- 2 The Referee has the authority to authorise (in exceptional circumstances) a non-nominated player to play in the final. The criteria that will be applied for eligibility for the finals for players are:
 - i) eligible for the age group
 - ii) has a BTM no
 - iii) has not represented the County in another age group this year other than in playing one match down.
 - iv) the rating of the player should be no higher than that of the singles players
 - v) will only be permitted to play doubles
- 3 A competitor may play in only one age group final.
- 4 Seniors Tennis GB reserves the right to impose an appropriate penalty should any county fail to take its place with a full team at the scheduled time in the final.
- 5 Each rubber will consist of two tiebreak sets and, if necessary, a third set of a championship tie break [to 10 points].
- 6 Matches will commence by 09.30 am with the exception of:-
Men's 65, 70 and Women's 65 at **12.45pm on Friday 29 November.**
- 7 Order of play – please see separate sheet sent out prior to Finals.

8 A limited number of practice courts will be available on each morning prior to commencement of play.

9 The Referee has discretion but their decision on all matters will be final. .

NOTE: Please take care when going onto court not to disturb any coaching session or other play on adjacent courts.
