INFORMATION FOR THOSE CLUBS WHO HAVE ENTERED THE ESSEX TENNIS INTER-CLUB SUMMER CUP COMPETITIONS 2025

- The First Round of the Cup competitions is scheduled to be played on the fixed weekend 12th/13 April and the Second Round on fixed weekend 3rd/4th May *(Bank Holiday). (The fixed weekends for all rounds are shown on each Cup Draw Sheet).
 *Providing both teams agree a Cup tie can be played before the fixed weekend

- 3) Clubs with two or more teams in the ladies or Men's competitions should nominate and submit their teams to the Competitions Organiser in compliance with Regulation **2**(a to g) of ESSEX TENNIS Competitions Regulations & Rules Booklet for Inter-Club Summer Cup Competitions or the Essex Tennis website below (copy and paste): https://www.essextennis.com/wp-content/uploads/2020/01/REGULATIONS-FOR-THE-INTER-CLUB-

- 4) Cup matches take preference over Essex league matches; however, if you have a <u>National</u> (i.e. playing a club from another county) League match on these dates and thus cannot field a team please contact George Sabiniak as soon as possible.
- 5) The + on the Draw Sheets indicates which team has the home draw. As the Home club should provide the courts, they are responsible for arranging a cup match with the Away club without undue delay. However, the Away club can make first contact if so desired. Providing both teams agree, a tie can be played before the Fixed Weekend.

The Organiser should be alerted to any problems or significant delay in arranging a match.

- 6) **Score Sheets/Cards**: The Summer Cups Score Sheets/ Cards must be used not Essex League Score Cards. The (BTM) Number of a player (which is the same as their LTA Membership Number) should be entered in the allocated space below their name on the Score Sheet to enable the match results to be recorded for (WTN)/Ranking purposes. If a player's BTM number is unknown at the time of the match, their First and Second Names should be accurately shown on the Score Sheet as it might enable their BTM Number to be determined by the organiser later.
- 6) Rubbers consist of best of 3 sets the first 2 being tie-break at 6-6 and if this results in 1 set each the deciding set will be a championship tie-break (first to 10 if 9-9 then 2 clear points), this championship tie-break counting as a set. Each pair plays against both opponent pairs. Should the match finish level on rubbers and sets, the play-off to decide the winners will be contested by one pair from each team, the chosen pair will comprise of one player from each pair who will play a championship tie-break. Top grade balls manufactured by the current Essex Tennis Sponsors (if applicable) must be used At present Slazenger and Dunlop.
- 7) **Walkovers**: If your team is not going to play the match, please give your opponents plenty of notice and also notify the Organiser. A record is kept of teams that give walkovers and if this is done two seasons running that team risks being excluded from the following year's competition.
- 8) **Results**: The Captain/ Match Secretary of the winning team shall email a copy of the score card to the organiser of the competition within 48 hours of the match being played.

 Failure to report a result promptly will automatically give you an away match in the next round.

 Failure to report a result at all will mean disgualification from the competition.
- 9) The Organiser should be informed of any recent change of participating club Match Secretary/main Summer Cup contact, as necessary.
