This year's event did not attract the normal support from our many Junior Players which was unfortunate. To increase participation some players played on just a single day which allowed them to participate in some much needed Matchy Practice. This was well received by the players.

The Saturday play involved the majority of players completing 2 matches with ultimate progression into the Semi-Finals of the Main Event & Playback positions within the tournament draw. The Sunday meant that the Semi Finalists were Marshall Tutu up against Kane Patience with David Wright playing with the 100% fit again Joel Cannell.. Marshall Tutu in the 1st semi-final, won against Kane Patience to advance to the final, whilst in the 2nd semi-final Joel Cannell emerged the winner against David Wright.
