

# SSEX TENNIS Junior County Matches and Expense Allowance for 1 Oct 22 till 30 Sept 23

Essex Tennis will enter Juniors teams in the following events

County Cup U8, U9, U10, U11, U12, U14 and U18

**Twelve Counties** 

Essex Tennis will aim to cover the costs of the coaches and players for the events, including accommodation and subsistence where required.

Where overnight accommodation is necessary, budget hotels such the Premier Inn/Travelodge or compatible will be used, with a target cost of £50 per person per night, including breakfast.

Players in the Under 14 and Under 18 County Cups are expected to share a twin-bedded room.

## County Cup Under 14's and under 18's.

Essex Tennis will take responsibility for the players, and book and pay for accommodation, meals and incidental expenses. Essex Tennis will endeavour to provide transport to and from the event, but at times it might be necessary for parents to assist, in which case they will be paid an allowance of £0.30 pence per mile, and if necessary, the cost of overnight accommodation.

The under 18's is a 3-day event

The under 14's is a 2-day qualifier, and if successful followed by a 3-day final.

#### County Cup Under 10's, Under 11's and Under 12's.

Each player to be accompanied by responsible parent/adult, unless otherwise agreed with the Lead Coach.

Parents are responsible for arranging their own transport, accommodation and subsistence.

Where overnight stays are necessary, Essex Tennis will contribute £50 per player per night, towards accommodation and subsistence.

Parents may claim a travel allowance of £0.30 per mile

All e age groups have a 2-day qualifier, and if successful followed by a 3-day final.

If a team reaches the final Essex tennis will book and pay for the accommodation for each child and one accompanying parent, normally in a family room, but the Parents are responsible for transport to and from the event and organising subsistence.

Parents can claim back mileage at £0.30 per mile, plus subsistence for 1 parent and the child, together with other out of pocket expenses.

### County Cup Under 8's and Under 9's.

Each player to be accompanied by responsible parent/adult.

The parents will be responsible for arranging their own transport to and from the event, and subsistence.

Parents may claim a travel allowance of £0.30 per mile and £10 a day towards subsistence.

These are both 1-day events

### Lionel Cox for Under 's 9, Under 10's and under 12's.

Each player to be accompanied by responsible parent/adult.

The parents will be responsible for arranging their own transport to and from the event, and any subsistence.

Parents may claim a travel allowance of £0.30 per mile and £10 a day towards subsistence.

The is a 2-day event for U10's and U12's and a 1-day event for U9's at Queenswood School Hatfield.

### Twelve Counties for Under 10's, Under 12's, Under 14's, Under16's and Under18's

Essex Tennis will take responsibility and arrange transport for the players in the U14, U16 and U18 events.

Players in the U10 and U12 teams will be accompanied by a responsible parent/adult and will provide their own transport to and from the event.

Parents may claim a travel allowance of £0.30 per mile and £10 a day towards subsistence.

This is a 1-day event

The above could involve up to 130 players over 51 tournament days, with a budgeted cost to Essex Tennis of £43,000.

Additionally, tracksuits and playing tops will be heavily subsidised at a further budgeted cost of £10,000.
