

# **INTRODUCING SAPKA**



The Sports and Play Construction Association (SAPCA) is the trade body for the UK's sports construction sector. It has more than 200 members – among them, the UK's leading tennis and padel court designers, contractors, equipment suppliers and professional service providers.

Working in partnership with the LTA, SAPCA published The SAPCA Code of Practice for the Construction of Padel Courts in 2021. The publication offers guidance on the basic construction requirements and specifications currently employed in building padel courts. The standards outlined throughout the document have been recognised and supported as the minimum level for the construction of padel courts in the UK.

### **COACHING UPDATE**

Existing racket sport coaches, who would like to sign up for LTA Introduction to Padel Coaching CPD can now do so via <u>the LTA website</u>. Completion of the one-day course provides 3 points towards the LTA tennis coaching license.

The LTA Coach Development & Support team has produced the new Padel Coaching Qualifications, the first 4-day Padel Instructor qualification launched earlier this year; anyone interested can register their interest <u>here</u>. The course costs £400. Coaches working at existing padel venues are prioritised, although the course will soon be delivered externally and will roll out more widely across the UK.



To prepare for the LTA Padel Instructor course you can complete the Readiness Test using the following links. This costs £36 and is carried out remotely/video based.

#### LTA Padel Instructor Readiness Test

The LTA Padel coaching team ran an *Introduction to Coaching the Double Glass* in August. Keep an eye out for this course when it next runs in the <u>CPD section of the LTA site</u>.

They have also developed a pilot course for *Coaching Kids Padel: Organisation, Skill Acquisition and Drills,* it ran on 28 September in Scotland, keep a look out for future courses. It is a one-day course and costs £40.
