To qualify, you need to be an LTA Senior Coach (Level 4) in tennis or have an equivalent qualification in coaching padel. Successful completion of the qualification allows you to join the LTA Tutor workforce, which means you'll be able to deliver LTA Padel Instructor qualifications and CPDs (Continuous Professional Development) to educate the next generation of padel coaches.

GB Seniors Women's 2023 Calendar of Events Announced and it includes two July Selection Events for the 2023/24 Squad Update from Sally Fisher

The 2023 GB Seniors Women's Calendar puts an emphasis on international match play and domestic tournament competition experience.

GB Seniors Selection Criteria will be used by the selectors at the two 2023 selection tournaments. Players interested to be considered for selection NEED ONLY ATTEND **ONE** of the two July selection events:

Player's LTA Padel Tour, FIP and WPT Open and Seniors Rankings and performance



- Player's performance and results in all tournaments played in previous 12 months, including National Training Camps, Regional or National Selection Events (at least 6 official tournament results in previous 12 months expected)
- All 4 'Performance' Factors will be considered- Mental; Physical; Tactical; Technical, along with Team Spirit

GB Seniors Women's Squad will be selected by a committee of at least 3, led by Nigel Garton (National Coach GB Seniors Women), Libby Fletcher and named guest selector(s)

Any player not currently involved in the GB Squad nor the Radar Group and who is competing successfully at LTA Grade 2 level or above, should get in contact through the @gb_seniors_padel Instagram account.

SENIORS OVERSEAS EVENTS

Throughout 2023 there are friendly overseas events which are not FIP or LTA sanctioned, but nonetheless present great opportunities for strong British players to test themselves against some of the best from other padel playing nations. GB Seniors will field a team to compete in in Palma in April. ISPT (International Senior Padel Tour Events) events are scheduled for later in the year.

Age categories are +40,45,50. Anyone who would like to be involved should contact Bjorn Schroder on mailto:bjoschroder@gmail.com or +44 7575 570057 and he will add you to the Facebook and What's App group. Bjorn tells me that it's usually a case of the more the merrier - if there is plenty of interest, either two teams are fielded, or occasionally players will make up the numbers for another team. Keep in mind these events do not currently adhere to the formal selection process in place for LTA and FIP sanctioned events, as they are informal and friendly, but Bjorn can apply selection criteria, most likely based on official ranking, if needed in the future.

COACHING UPDATE

The LTA have undertaken 3 successful pilots of the forthcoming **LTA Padel Instructor** qualification. As a result, final tweaks are being made to the course before it launches in early 2023 for delivery by Coach Development Centres. This means that there will be a proliferation of courses across the UK and throughout the year.

The LTA Instructor qualification entails 4 days' core training, face to face with the Tutor plus one further five-hour Elective workshop, from a choice of two. The Electives will be how to Coach the Double Glass and How to Coach Kids' Padel. Both will also be open to non-qualification coaches wishing to do the courses as CPD. Coaches wishing to prepare for the Padel Instructor qualification will need to do a Padel Instructor Readiness Test, which can be booked via the LTA Course Search Tool. The test costs £36 and is carried out remotely/video based. All assessments are now centralised, which means that upon successful completion of the Padel Instructor: Core Training, coaches will need to book and successfully complete their Padel Instructor Summative Assessment as the final step.

Existing racket sport coaches, who would like to sign up for the one day LTA Introduction to Padel Coaching CPD can now do so via <u>the LTA website</u>. Completion of the one-day course provides 3 points towards the LTA tennis coaching license.
