

OUR GOALS

We are a voluntary 'not for profit' organization run by volunteers from clubs around the County, a team of 60 plus volunteers.

Our aim is to support and safeguard tennis providers, coaches, players, parents and any person who is involved in the game.

- We assist tennis clubs in Essex to develop their facilities and increase membership to enable more people to play tennis
- > We provide grants and interest free loans
- We provide competitive opportunities in age groups from under 8s to over 70s
- We have particular interest in young players and providing disability tennis opportunities

Supporting Clubs

- > We support over 100 clubs across Essex
- ➤ Our 'Advantage Essex' scheme provides clubs with access to Grants and Loans with currently £0.5m-£0.75m loans in place
- ➤ This allows Clubs to develop or improve their tennis offering and/or facilities e.g.
 - > new floodlights;
 - > conversion to LED;
 - resurface or build new courts, including specialist Mini and Padel courts;
 - clubhouse improvements;installation of a defibrillator; and
 - > new tennis equipment
- ➤ The County Office keeps in touch with our Clubs both directly and via our team of Area Reps, allowing Clubs to raise questions/issues directly with the team at Essex Tennis, allowing feedback to come from them and also better informs our interaction with the LTA

Supporting Adult Players

- ➤ We support the costs involved for our Men's and Women's Adult teams at the annual County Week and Winter Cup and also Adult County age-group teams from 35 plus to 70 plus
- ➤ We link up players with teams/venues through our 'Find a Club' scheme, which helps players new to the sport or moving into the area to find an appropriate place to play
- ➤ We run summer and winter leagues for Clubs around the County, both Open and Vets, with over 130 Club teams participating

Safeguarding

➤ We provide support and advice for Club's and Club Welfare Officers as needed and act as a liaison point between the LTA's safeguarding team and process and our Clubs

Redbridge

- ➤ We have a long-term user agreement with 30 years remaining
- ➤ This provides free dedicated court time throughout the year, used for County training, Talent ID days and Inter County matches
- ➤ Separate arrangements give access to court time at Deanes and Connaught

Supporting Junior Players

- ➤ We support the costs of our teams playing in tournaments or competitions, incl team kit
- ➤ We liaise and support the Essex Tennis Parents & Friends Association (ETPFA) which provides a direct link between Essex Tennis and parents
- ➤ County training is held regularly and allows the County coaches to develop skills, match tactics and team spirit among our age-group teams
- ➤ Inter County events give Junior players the opportunity to represent Essex in team competition at Regional and National levels
- ➤ We support LTA sanctioned tournaments across the County, including the Essex Junior Closed and Open events

Coaches & Coach Education

➤ We support coach training for coaches across the County running over 20 courses and 2 Coach Forums per year at Redbridge, Southend, Colchester and Deanes

Disability

➤ We support and facilitate access to tennis courts by disability players and champion disability specific events and competitions throughout the season

MONEY SPENT ON ESSEX TENNIS

We typically have annual income of circa £250k:

- 60% from Club subscriptions
- 40% from commercial and other activity

This is spent approx. as follows:

- Club support 25%
- ❖ Junior support 30%
- Adult support 20%
- Operational 20%
- Surplus/contingency 5%
