

Financial Summary of the year to September 2023

Essex Tennis has had another successful year both on and off the tennis court, and whilst the surplus is lower than in 2022, is was still very healthy at £120,000. The decrease was caused by 2 main reasons, the increase in expenditure on playing kit for the county teams, and the changed approach to LTA funding, so instead of Esses Tennis receiving the clubs registration fees, which were from 1 Oct to 30 Sept, we now receive a grant for the 12 month to December, so this resulted in only 75% of the grant being taken into account this financial year.
